What do I need to do for auditions?

- We will warm up, do a few theatre games, and read from the attached scenes; be familiar with the parts you are interested in/ memorize if possible. We are looking to see what character voices you can do to suit the show.
- If auditioning by video, choose 1 or 2 of the scenes below and perform all the characters with different voices.

Do I need a headshot?

- We will take a head shot of each person when they arrive.

What do I need to wear for auditions?

- Wear something comfortable that you can move in. Black or muted colors are preferred. It should not be overly tight or revealing and you should be able to move freely in your outfit. Also, wear closed-toe shoes you can move in, no heels or dress shoes.

What do rehearsals look like?

- Rehearsals will be spread out across the months of November and December. You can find the rehearsal schedule after the rehearsal form.
- Come to rehearsal ready to work! We will hit the ground running with memorizing lines, working on scenes, and building our characters. It is expected that at every rehearsal you have a positive attitude and are ready to work hard and participate!

What if I have conflicts?

- We are all busy, if you have conflicts, please complete the conflict calendar sheet. We do ask that you are able to make 80% or more of the rehearsals.

ROLES:

Charlie Brown, Lucy, Linus, Sally, Schroeder, Pig Pen, Frieda, Violet, Patty, Shermey and Snoopy (no lines in the production so bring the character!)

CHARLIE BROWN

Well, it's good seeing you all here. As you know, we are going to put on the Christmas play. Due to the shortage of time, we'll get right down to work. One of the first things to ensure a good performance, pay strict attention to the director. I'll keep my directions simple. If I point to the right, it means focus attention stage right. (back to professional persona, clears her throat) You need involvement. You need to get involved in some real Christmas project. How would you like to be the director of the Christmas play? Sure Charlie Brown. We need a director. You need involvement. We've got shepherds, musicians, animals, everyone we need. We've even got a Christmas Queen. Don't worry. I'll be there to help you. I'll meet you in the auditorium. Incidentally, I know how you feel about all this Christmas business, getting depressed and all that. It happens to me every year. I never get what I really want. I always get lots of stupid toys or a bicycle or clothes or something like that. I want Real Estate.

SALLY

Dear Santa Claus, How've you been? Did you have a nice summer? How is your wife? I have been extra good this year, so I have a long list of presents that I want. Please note the size and color of each item and send as many as possible. If it seems too complicated, make it easy on
